

Your Giving to Good News Family Care Made More Effective with GIFT AID

How Does It Work?

The Gift Aid Scheme allows taxpayers to give to charities in such a way that tax you have already paid can be claimed back and *added* to your giving. With basic rate tax at 22%, every £1 you give to Good News Family Care, increases in value to £1.28

What Payments Can I Make?

You can make regular monthly payments, single gifts or ask us to reclaim tax on all your donations until further notice, no matter how sporadic.

Can Anyone Do It?

You need to be a taxpayer and pay enough Income Tax or Capital Gains tax in each year to cover the tax we reclaim on your giving.

Is There Any Cost To Me?

None whatsoever.

What Are My Obligations?

None; there is no legal commitment to continue. If for any reason you need to stop, you can.

What If I Pay A Higher Rate Of Tax?

Good news! — Higher rate tax payers receive *extra* relief claimed through their tax return

What Else Should I Know?

- Your Gift Aid donations should be based on the tax paid by you personally— not another person (e.g. husband or wife).
- If you cease to be a tax payer - or to pay enough tax - please notify us so that we don't reclaim too much tax on your giving. (*you will be liable to refund the Inland Revenue if too much tax is recovered*)

How Do I Start?

- (1) Complete the attached application form (including the Standing Order form section if applicable).
